Session met for its stated meeting on May 21, 2024, at 5:15pm in the office conference room.

Operations: April 2024 finances were received and approved.

Endowment: End of April \$572,664. Beginning of April \$621,580. Beginning of 2024 \$568,007.

Building & Property: Ruling Elder Coulter working on estimates to replace second story windows facing South Street.

Adult Discipleship: Unified Sunday school for Adults and Youth (rising 7th graders and up) commencing May 26 through August 11. Video topics will be *The Holiness of God* and *Chosen by God* by RC Sproul.

Youth Discipleship: A summer rafting trip is being considered. SOS forms have been emailed to parents. Plans are underway to paint the youth room this summer.

Children's Discipleship: Search continuing for new Children's Ministry Director.

Communication & Evangelism: Efforts to communicate effectively underway. Bulletin announcements are emailed each week. Facebook updated regularly.

Kindergarten: Spring program last month, with standing room only (>40 more than chairs). Great outreach! Last day of school 22 May. Next year's teachers are being interviewed.

Mission & Outreach: Will be collecting for the local food pantry and for international focus collecting for the Rise Against Hunger. We are partnering with CSUMC during SOS to put together meals to aid foreign hunger relief with Rise Against Hunger.

Officer Nominating: 7 Elder nominations and 5 Deacon nominations were received.

Worship: Communion is scheduled for June 2, 2024. More bulletins will be printed each week due to rising worship attendance.

Old Business: Review of 2023 deacon's minutes. Motion carried.

New Business: Jones/Larson wedding approved.
